CITY CHARTER AMENDMENT #10

SUPER MAJORITY VOTE TO CHANGE TEXT OF FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

Shall Section 2.11(b) of the Charter be amended to add a subsection 10 which will provide that any change to the objectives, goals or policies in the Future Land Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan may be made only by an affirmative vote in support of such change by a minimum of four votes of Commission Members who are physically present at the meeting when the voter is taken.

Explanation: When a majority (3) of our elected commissioners vote to change our city's master plan (the Comprehensive Plan), two (2) of the commissioners (representing the minority opinion) can override the vote. There are five people on the City Commission. If this referendum passes, any two of them will control what happens to our city's master plan.
