NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

On November 06, 2010, at approximately 1522 hours, I was dispatched to the lobby of the Winter Park Police Department, located at 500 North Virginia Avenue, in reference to a battery. Upon arrival, I met with the victim, Bonnie Jackson (W/F 08-29-63), who provided a sworn written statement and the following information:

On the above mentioned date, at approximately 1000 hours, Jackson arrived at Fleet People's Park, located at 2000 South Lakemont Avenue, for a public meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss recent changes being made at the park. The meeting took place around a picnic table, and Jackson estimates that approximately ten people were in attendance.

During this time, Jackson claims that several individuals began to single her out and accuse her of wanting to close the park. At this point, Jackson alleged that a woman by the name of Sandra Womble (W/F [REDACTED]) became very confrontational, came behind her (on her left side), and shoved her on her left arm. Jackson proceeded to tell Womble "Never touch me again." Jackson said that Womble called her names to include "Bitch" "Bully" and "Liar".

Jackson stated that a man by the name of Joseph C. Brock (W/M [REDACTED]) was also in attendance. Jackson mentioned that Brock was screaming at her and causing a scene.

Jackson is currently a sitting member of Parks and Recreations, and knows both Womble and Brock from their appearances at prior meetings.

Although I explained to Jackson that yelling at someone and cursing are not crimes, she did feel that Brock affected the peace and quiet of others at the park. She further believes that his behavior was a breach of peace.

Furthermore, Jackson did not give Womble permission to touch her in any way, and she advised that she will press charges.

I was not able to take statements from any other party involved (since this information was provided after the fact, and I was not on scene). Jackson was provided a copy of her statement, along with a Victim's Rights Pamphlet.

NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

VICTIM: BONNIE JACKSON
SUSPECT: SANDRA WOMBLE

I was assigned to this case on November 9, 2010.

This case involved a reported battery which occurred at Fleet Peoples Park, 2000 Lakemont Avenue South, sometime between 1000 hours and 1200 hours on November 6, 2010. Bonnie Jackson reported that during a public meeting of Friends of Fleet Peoples Park, Sandra Womble, a white female born on ~~07/22/1977~~, battered Bonnie Jackson by poking Bonnie Jackson on the left upper arm with her fingertips. Bonnie Jackson reported that Sandra Womble poked her in this manner two (2) times with enough force to shove Bonnie Jackson aside. Bonnie Jackson reported that she then told Sandra Womble not to touch her again. Bonnie Jackson indicated Sandra Womble is known to her from meetings before the City of Winter Park Parks and Recreation Commission, of which Bonnie Jackson is a sitting member.

Additionally, Bonnie Jackson reported that other individuals in attendance of the meeting, Joseph C. Brock and Carla Lubet, screamed and yelled at her in an apparent effort to get her to leave the park. The initial report indicated Bonnie Jackson expressed the belief that the actions of these individuals were possibly a criminal offense of breach of public peace. No other complaints of a breach of public peace were reported to this agency on the date and time in question.

On November 9, 2010 I spoke to Bonnie Jackson by telephone. Ms. Jackson confirmed her account of the incident as described in her sworn statement. Ms. Jackson advised she sustained no bruising or other physical injuries as a result of the alleged battery. I asked Ms. Jackson if she was able to provide information about other possible witnesses to the alleged battery. Ms. Jackson advised she did not know of any witnesses that observed the alleged battery as it occurred. Ms. Jackson provided the following names of individuals at the park at the time of the incident: Joseph Edmonds, Robert Atkins (407-227-5275), Pat Fishback, Gerhard Adler (407-491-6890). Ms. Jackson advised Gerhard Adler was at the park to photograph violations of the park policies occurring on the day in question. Ms. Jackson confirmed she would be able to positively identify Sandra Womble from a photo lineup.

I explained to Bonnie Jackson that there was insufficient evidence to charge any of the aforementioned individuals with breach of the public peace. I informed Ms.

Jackson that Winter Park Police did not receive any calls to respond to the park at the time of the alleged incident and there have been no additional complaints that the actions of these individuals constituted a breach of the public peace.

On November 9, 2010 I received two (2) e-mails from Bonnie Jackson in which she provided a copy of an e-mail apparently sent by Sandra Womble to the mayor and commissioners of the City of Winter Park, a copy of a letter sent from Bonnie Jackson to John Fishback (Chairman of The Friends of Fleet Peoples Park, Inc.), and a web link to the aforementioned photos posted by Gerhard Adler. In the e-mail allegedly sent by Sandra Womble, Ms. Womble advised she "inadvertently" touched the arm of Bonnie Jackson during the meeting, to which Ms. Jackson responded by threatening to call the police and file charges against Sandra Womble.

On November 9, 2010 I attempted to contact Sandra Womble by telephone. I left a message requesting that she phone me back.

On November 10, 2010 I made contact with Sandra Womble by telephone. Ms. Womble agreed to meet with me at the Winter Park Police Department in order to provide a sworn statement.

On November 10, 2010 at approximately 1500 hours I met with Sandra Womble at the Winter Park Police Department. At this time Ms. Womble provided a sworn statement in which she advised that on the date in question she attended a meeting of the Friends of Fleet Peoples Park at Fleet Peoples Park. Ms. Womble advised Bonnie Jackson attended the meeting and several verbal disagreements occurred between Ms. Jackson and other attendees of the meeting. Ms. Womble stated that she overheard Bonnie Jackson speaking to a group of people and wished to contribute to the conversation. Ms. Womble stated that she approached Bonnie Jackson on Ms. Jackson's left side and touched Bonnie Jackson on the left forearm with the palm of her hand. Ms. Womble described her actions as "non-aggressive and benign". Ms. Womble stated Bonnie Jackson immediately jerked her arm away and told Ms. Womble not to touch her again or she'll file charges against her. Ms. Womble stated she folded her arms against her chest while Bonnie Jackson challenged her to touch her again. Ms. Womble advised she backed away from Ms. Jackson.

At my request, Sandra Womble provided names and contact numbers for possible witnesses present at the scene who observed the interaction between Sandra Womble and Bonnie Jackson. Ms. Womble advised the following people were

On November 10, 2010 I spoke to Kaile Howell by telephone. Ms. Howell confirmed she was at the park at the date and time in question and did observe the interaction between Bonnie Jackson and Sandra Womble. Ms. Howell agreed to meet with me at the Winter Park Police Department on November 10, 2010 and provide a sworn statement.

On November 10, 2010 I spoke to Janice Cullity by telephone. Ms. Cullity confirmed she was at the park at the date and time in question and did observe the interaction between Bonnie Jackson and Sandra Womble. Ms. Howell stated that Sandy Womble walked over to join the conversation and gently touched Bonnie Jackson on her left elbow. Ms. Howell advised Sandra Womble appeared to do this in an effort to let Bonnie Jackson know she was standing next to her and to join the conversation. Ms. Howell stated that Bonnie Jackson then shouted "don't push me", to which Sandra Womble responded that she had not done so. Ms. Howell advised Bonnie Jackson replied "then don't touch me". Ms. Howell advised she, herself, commented to Bonnie Jackson that there was no need to "make something out of nothing".

On November 11, 2010 I spoke to Jason Snow by telephone. Mr. Snow advised he did not witness anyone touch or batter anyone else while he was at Fleet Peoples Park on the date in question. Mr. Snow advised he observed Bonnie Jackson loudly arguing and pointing in the faces of several attendees of the meeting in question.

On November 11, 2010 I attempted to generate a photo lineup for Sandra Womble using the DataWorks Plus system. I found no booking photos on file for Sandra Womble.

On November 11, 2010 I requested a photo lineup of Sandra Womble to be generated by the Orange County Sheriff's Office Identification Section using the photo on file for her Florida driver's license.

On November 11, 2010 I attempted to locate contact numbers for possible witnesses Joseph Edmonds and Pat Fishback using an online search. I was able to locate a possible address for Joseph Edmonds (1832 Pineview Circle in Winter Park) and a contact number for Patricia Fishback (407-645-4649).

On November 11, 2010 I attempted to contact Patricia Fishback by telephone. I left a message requesting that she phone me back.

On November 11, 2010 I attempted to make contact with Joseph Edmonds at 1832 Pineview Circle in Winter Park. There was no answer at the door when I knocked repeatedly. I left a business card at the door containing a note requesting that the resident contact me regarding a case I am investigating.

SUPPLEMENT #2

On November 12, 2010 I spoke to Patricia Fishback by telephone. Mrs. Fishback advised he did not witness a battery while he was at Fleet Peoples Park on the date in question. Mrs. Fishback confirmed she witnessed many of the attendees question whether Bonnie Jackson had a right to be at the meeting being held at the public park.

On November 12, 2010 I at approximately 1505 hours I met with Jeff Kindred at the Winter Park Police Department. Mr. Kindred provided a sworn statement in which he stated that on November 6, 2010, while he was at a meeting to discuss proposed fees for Fleet Peoples Park, he witnessed Bonnie Jackson and Sandra Womble engage in a heated discussion. Mr. Kindred stated that both Bonnie Jackson and Sandra Womble raised their voices during the discussion. Mr. Kindred advised he witnessed Sandra Womble very gently place her fingertips on the forearm of Bonnie Jackson in an apparent attempt to get Bonnie Jackson's attention and to get her to lower her voice. Mr. Kindred advised he was approximately three (3) feet away from both women when this occurred. Mr. Kindred advised he witnessed Bonnie Jackson immediately tell Sandra Womble not touch her and say she would sue Sandra Womble if she ever touched her again. Mr. Kindred advised the meeting continued for an additional forty-five (45) to sixty (60) minutes with further heated discussions involving Bonnie Jackson occurring.

On November 16, 2010 I was contacted by Sandra Womble regarding this case. I advised Ms. Womble I was unable to provide any information about this active investigation. Ms. Womble informed me she had retained Attorney Chan Mueller for legal counsel.

On November 18, 2010 I was contacted by Jim Younger regarding this case. Mr. Younger confirmed he was employed by Attorney Chan Mueller and asked that I agree to meet with him to discuss this case prior to charging Sandra Womble with a criminal offense. I advised Mr. Younger I was unable to provide any information about this active investigation, but would take under review any information Chan Mueller wished to present on behalf of his client.

This investigation will continue.




At approximately 10:00 a.m., I arrived at Fleet Peoples Park for a public meeting to hear what residents thought about recent changes being made at the park. The meeting was around a concrete picnic table and there were only about 10 people there. After listening for 5-10 minutes, a couple people began to single me out with finger pointing and accusations that I wanted to close the park, and was leading the charge to get rid of dogs. A few people began yelling at me and others demanded that I answer questions. A vocal resident named Sandy Womble said that I ruined their meeting by my presence, that I had no right to be there, and she began collecting names & contact information for a meeting to be held at her house. I began speaking with a calm group of about 4 people. After about 20-30 minutes of discussion, Sandy Womble came up behind me and on my left side and gave me 2 hard pokes in my left arm to shove me aside and enter the group conversation. I advised Sandy never to touch me again. She called me a "bitch" and a "liar," and a "bully" and repeated that I had no business in the park. I know Sandy from her appearances at meetings before the Parks & Recreation Commission where I am a sitting member. During this time, I was also screamed at repeatedly by Joseph C. Brock to leave the park and to "get out of here" and to "shut up." I was also shouted at by Carla Lubet. I can identify Joseph and Carla the same way that I know Sandy at public meetings.


